**Easy steps to enter**

2. Entrants must submit an electronic copy in PDF format and a hardcopy of the design.
3. Entrants may submit more than one design. Each design must be submitted with a separate entry form.
4. If you enter as part of a team or collaboration, it is important that you elect a team leader or contact person and also list all participants on the entry form. Only the names on the entry form will be considered the winners if successful.

  - Brief report of your philosophy underpinning your design including your aesthetic inspiration.
  - An accurate quarter scale model must be submitted. The model can be made out of any material.
  - Signed entry form.
  - Signed terms and conditions.

**TERMS & CONDITIONS**

- The competition is divided into two categories: a closed competition for registered students and an open competition for furniture designers and professionals.
- Foreign nationals need to be in the possession of a valid resident permit.
- Entrants must be 18 years or older.
- Entrants may submit more than one design. Each design must be submitted with a separate entry form.
- Entrants must submit an electronic copy in PDF format and a hardcopy of the design.
- All scanned entries must be signed.
- Your electronic and hardcopy entries must be accompanied by:
  - Technical drawings or accurate sketching including dimensions and 3D drawings (CAD or free illustrations) of the design.
  - Description of the design and materials.
  - Brief report of your philosophy underpinning your design including your aesthetic inspiration.
  - An accurate quarter scale model must be submitted. The model can be made out of any material.
  - Signed entry form.
  - Signed terms and conditions.
- Participants take part and enter the competition at their own risk, and the companies bear no responsibility for any loss, damage or harm suffered as a result of participation.
- Only original and complete entries will be entered into the competition.
- The outcome of the competition is subject to the decision of the judges of the competition whose decision is final and no negotiations and/or correspondence will be entered into once the final decision has been made.
- The WCFC employees, judges, directors, advertising agents and sponsors or their immediate family are not allowed to participate in the competition.
- Closing date must be adhered to. No extensions will be given.
- The finalists will be notified telephonically and via email.
- The finalists will have eight weeks to manufacture an actual product.
- Winners names will be announced on 4 March 2012 at Design Indaba Expo 2012.
- Finalists will forfeit their participation in the competition if they fail to attend the prize giving at Design Indaba Expo on 4 March 2012.
- The *Design Stage* entries will be judged according to the following criteria:
  - Originality and innovation
  - Ease of manufacturing and assembly (as set out in your technical drawing)
  - Brief report of the stylistic and aesthetic inspiration and description of the design and materials
  - An accurate quarter scale model must be submitted. The model can be made out of any material
- The *Design Stage* finalists entries will proceed to the *Manufacturing Stage* and will be judged according to the following criteria:
  - Predominantly invasive alien wood, i.e. Red River Gum- Eucalyptus (to be supplied) can also include steel, plastic, etc.
  - A brief report on what your main problems and contingencies were during manufacturing
  - Commercial viability
  - Functionality
- Entrants must complete all information as requested above for judging as no marks will be given to information not submitted.
- The final manufactured product must reflect the drawing.
- The final manufactured product must be delivered to the WCFC Offices by the 17 February 2012.
- Finalists' furniture to be displayed at Design Indaba Expo from 29 February to 4 March 2012.
- Finalists to collect their finished product after the show 4 March 2012 at their own expense.
- The intellectual property belongs to the entrant.
- There will be five finalists from each category.
- Finalists must provide their own décor / accessories for the exhibition display at the Design Indaba Expo from 29 February to 4 March 2012.
